## County balks at endorsing housing center

Oakland's fledgling Open Housing Center has met resistance.
But the resistance came from an unexpected source, reminding bystanders of the qulp by Pogo, "We have met the enemy and he is us."
The center, which officially opens its doors Tuesday in Farmington Hills, is a nonprofit agency that

hopes to promote integration in Oak-land neighborhoods, according to Ann Wettlaufer who is co-director with Barbara Talley.






