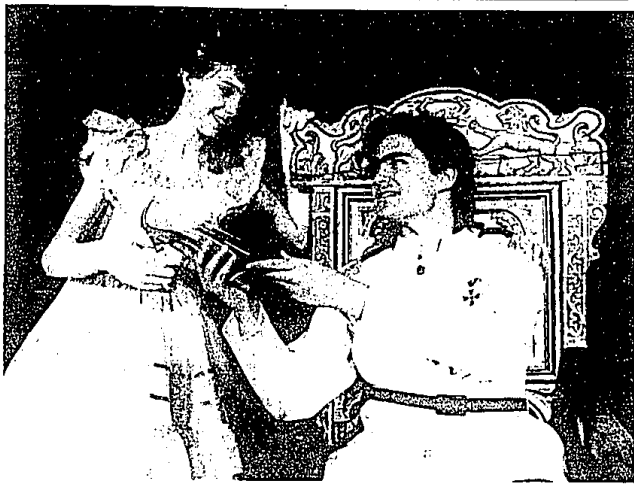
Winan brothers

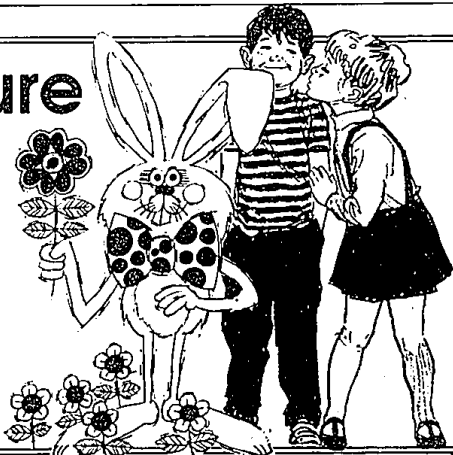

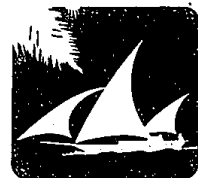
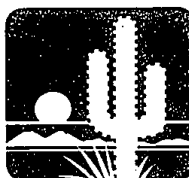
