

In 1923, a farmhouse near 12 Mile and Townline Road, now Inkster Road, was bought only to be destroyed by fire in 1928. With the help of Sarah Fisher, wife of Charles Fisher of Fisher Bedy Co, fame, and an additional 80 acres, the existing permanent structure was built.

THE ENGLISH-STYLE children's village of cottages and main building of Georgian architecture is named after Fisher and St. Vincent DePaul, the patron saint of charity.
