● ELECTED PRESIDENT

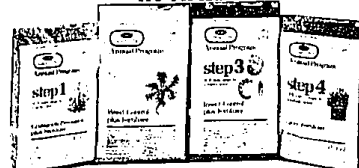

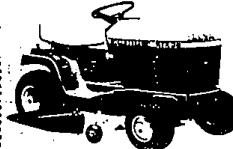

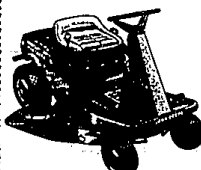
