Bill Schweite of Midland, in the polls. Durant dismisses that, however, in-sisting it doesn't accurately reflect support of voters fed up with govern-ment.

North's endorso-ment will give him momentum against Democratic incumbent Carl Levin in the fall campaign, he said. "This rally is an important snap shot of the campaign," Durant said at a preas conference prior to the rally. "But it's part of a broader plan.
