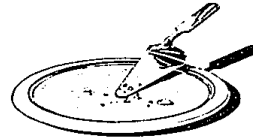


## Foster parent thanked

Guest speaker will be Rabbi Harold S. Kushner, spiritual leader of Temple Israel of Natick, Mass. and noted author of two best-sellers "When Bad Things Happen to Good People" and "When All You've Ever Wanted Isn't Enough."

The Jewish Theological Seminary of America was founded in New York City in 1886 to train rabbinical students in the U.S. and is today the academic and spiritual center of Conservative Judaism throughout the world. It contains four schools of academic study in its New York cen-
