Old Sheets Needed For Dressings

A call is out for old sheets and pillowcases to be made into dressings by Michigan Cancer Foundation volunteers.

Both white and pastel sheets are suitable, said Mrs. Theresa Jahn, chairman of the Livonia branch of the foundation, but they must be cotton muslin or percale.

"We cannot use permanent press, drip-dry or no-iron materials, because they are not absorbent enough to be used for dressing," Mrs. Jahn added.

WOMEN'S groups sew dressings that are distributed free to patients who need them. The Michigan Cancer Foundation supplies the cellulose inner padding, but sheeting used for the outer covering must be collected.

Householders are urged to deliver contributions to the foundation's Plymouth office, 173 N. Main any week day between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Sheets and pillowcases discarded by hotels, motels, laundries, hospitals and nursing homes also can be used, and institutions with supplies to donate may call the Plymouth office, 453-3010, to have them picked up.

"EVERY YEAR we distribute about 150,000 dressings to patients from our western Wayne County Office," Mrs. Jahn said, "so our need for old sheeting is tremendous and never ending."

Dressings are made in seven different sizes, ranging from four-inch squares to large pads measuring 18 by 24 inches.

About two-thirds of the dressings made by Michigan Cancer Foundation volunteers go to cancer patients. The remainder are given to patients suffering from other diseases and conditions which create a need for dressings.

The Michigan Cancer Foundation is the only cancer control agency within the United Foundation. The dressing program is one of several services provided to cancer patients. Others include programs in cancer research and community education.
