His 'low-key' humor keeps 'em laughing

BORN AND raised in Jackson, Norkey said he got a late start on his career as a professional comedian, but is now plying his trade coast to coast.

"I have admired comedians ever since I can remember, and now I'm living out my fantasy, Not many can say that."

The goal for all of us (comodians) is to break into the big time and when you do that you are probably going to have to make the move to Los Angeles. "That's when you are in a new town and starting all over again. That's another fantasy to live and turn into reality."


