SPRAGUE RECENTLY previewed the shells that will be fired up over the skies of Southfield.

As in years past, the show will open on a bang with a finale-styled intro-duction and conclude in a big way as well. Some of the shells are 12 inches, breaking into a multitude of colors and covering thousands of feet in the sky.

What makes the Zambellis among the best in the business is their ability to provide a wide array of displays and dazzling colors, Sprague said. The company manufactures a majority of its fireworks at its New Castle, Pa.based factory.

"The recipe is highly secret," Spraene said.

"If they don't manufacture the shells, they will build their own lift charge so the shells can go higher in the air." Sprague said. "That's import-

ANOTHER IMPORTANT aspect the safety measures that are taken at such exhibits.

Licensed pyrotechnists will be used to send off the fireworks. Other precautions include digging steel mortars into the ground to prevent any shell from going off course. Also, fireworks on the ground are covered by a tarpaulin so they are not ignited premature-

ly.
