

Chief: No endorsement made in race for bench

opponent, Frederick "Rick" Knauer of Farmington Hills.

THE PHOTO of the trio is in Harris' campaign literature for election to the 4th District Court bench. Blanchard appointed Harris in May 1989 to complete the remaining 1 1/2 year of the six-year term held by former Judge Michael Hand who retired.

"It was not a non-consenting photo in that they posed for the photo, I was there," said Holtz, who added that if use of the photo is a problem, it is his fault, not Harris'.

"It seemed to me the way it was



taken — posed — one would assume it would be used for the purposes it was," Holtz said. "This was a posed picture. I wish there wouldn't be a story. This is dumb."

Dwyer acknowledged that indeed he posed with the governor and Harris. "No, I didn't know he was going to use the photo. I'm not giving

endorsements. If he (Holtz) wanted to use the photo, I guess that's his prerogative."

Holtz — and Dwyer agrees — said he doesn't believe that the photo implies endorsement of Harris as a judicial candidate. "And nowhere have I said that's the case," Holtz said.

Though the photo also shows Blanchard, Holtz said Harris has not received the governor's endorsement. The campaign brochure also shows a certificate of appreciation from President George Bush. "I was trying to achieve some Republican-Democrat balance. Do you think George Bush endorsed Judge Harris?" Holtz asked.

a "cheerful ambassador of good will."

NICOLAY is also involved with other community activities, including chairing the administrative board at Nardin Park church. She is past secretary of the United Methodist Women and helped found the Pacesettlers' Couples' Group several years ago. She also sits on the board of directors for the Farmington Area YMCA, is a member of the Optimist Club, and sits on the Farmington Hills Police Crime Prevention Advisory Committee.

Various groups have given her awards over the years. She was the 1985 Optimist Citizen of the Year,

received an award from the Michigan Academy of Volunteer leadership and was named a Junior League of Birmingham honoree for the Governor's Volunteer Honor Roll in 1989, among others.

Her FFIA activities have guided her to other, related activities, as well. She is trained and active in the Maplegrove Speakers Bureau, a chemical dependency treatment arm of Henry Ford Hospital in West Bloomfield. Working with local police, she was instrumental in the adoption of the host party ordinance in Farmington Hills. She also sits on the health subcommittee for the new code of conduct and health curriculum for Farmington Public Schools.

Her overall philosophy seems to

draw her to these things.

"I always think there's a solution to every problem," she said. "I just have to see what it is. My husband always tells me I can't take care of the whole world."

Nonetheless, she tries. Nicolay lives in the Wood Creek subdivision with her husband Bud, her one-time high school sweetheart. They have three children: Nick, 35, Kathy, 28 and Jim, 24, all graduates of Harrison High School in Farmington Hills.
