## Police academy grads join Hills department

12 weeks of training.
At graduation ceremonies, Farmington Hills, police Chief William
Dwyer presented Flubart with the
marksmanship award for chalking
up the high score in the Michigan
Law Enforcement Officer's Firearms Qualification Course.
The three new officers bring the

department's total of sworn officers to 97. The new officers 'will enable the department to provide an even greater concentration of personnel to the neighborhoods,' Dywer said.

The new officers began their law enforcement careers in the department's police cadet program. They are now in the second phase of their la-month training program.

In the second phase, the new offi-cers will team up with a certified po-lice trainer for 4½ months and will be independently evaluated on their readiness to perform their duties.
