

Club gymnasts set for Classic

The biggest event of the year for area club gymnasts takes place this weekend at Eastern Michigan University.

The Michigan Academy of Gymnastics in Westland will be co-host for the 12th Annual Christmas Classic on Saturday and Sunday in Bowen Field House.

Admission is \$4 for adults and \$2 for students.

More than 400 gymnasts from Michigan, New Jersey, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Kentucky, Indiana and Illinois are expected to compete. The metro area also will be represented by clubs from Rochester, Roseville, Warren, Ann Arbor, Farmington and Bloomfield Hills.

"Canton (Ohio) Gymnastics is the defending team champ.

Michigan has only 30 gymnasts who compete at Level 10, and four belong to Michigan Academy. The quartet consists of Devon and Danielle Cunningham, Shawna Gunnis and Carrie Thompson.

Other Michigan Academy gymnasts expected to do well this weekend are Gina Genrich, Jana Stojanovich and Zoe Yockey at Level 7 and Lisa Blackmer, Anne Abramczyk and Sara Stojanovich at Level 6.

Genrich was second on vault in the Judges Meet at EMU recently, and the Level 6 trio was fourth in team competition.

The Farmington Hills City Council will give formal consideration to Cluster Site Plan No. 70-3-90, with 48 dwelling units and an open space plan on 41.29 acres, located in an R1A-1, Single-Family Residential district. The property involved is located on the east side of Drake Road, south of I-696 and is more particularly described as follows:
