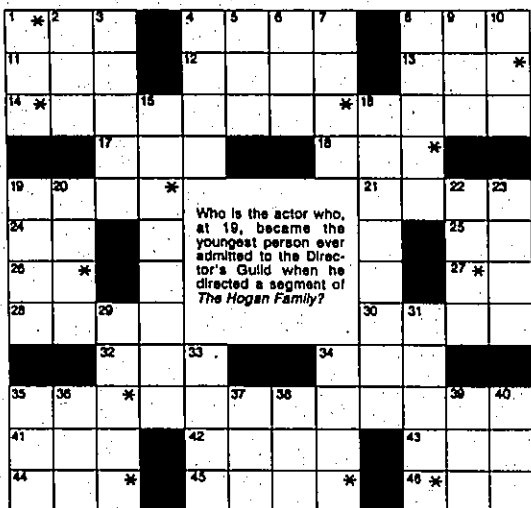


## CROSSWORD PUZZLE

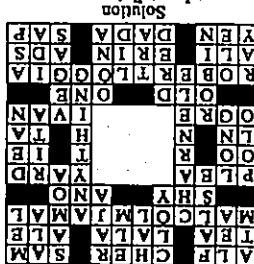
