

# Defining 'Love' Is An Awesome Challenge

**FARMINGTON**  
Back in the 1930's when newspapers operated on a more personal basis, the editor of a small town Alabama daily offered any reader \$10 who could define in 100 words or less the meaning of the word "love."

Nobody ever collected. As his readers had smugly guessed, the search for love's meaning was the last throes of a "swinging" young bachelor succumbing to its lure.

Editor Julian Hall was killed a few years later in an auto accident. But if he had survived and had "covered" Monday night's Farmington Board of Education meeting, he could have learned why no one could meet his offer.

Details of a proposed Farmington family life curriculum, including human sexuality, were presented at a public study session.

The educators figure it would take 13 years from kindergarten through 12th grade to cover what Hall

wanted answered in 100 words or less.

**THE PROPOSAL** extends from a development of a concept of self worth, family relationships, friendships, consideration of others as individuals, and community responsibilities, to human reproduction, dating and preparation for marriage.

"What we are trying to do is to emphasize human understanding," said Lawrence G. Freedman, principal of Wood Creek elementary school and program coordinator.

"We want to show human sexuality as only one part of family life and human relationships, not vice versa."

An unexpectedly small audience of just 85 persons attended the presentation.

and 55 of them were school-connected. Only 30 private citizens, including a half dozen teenagers, showed up.

**A PUBLIC** hearing on the suggested new curriculum will be held Monday, March 8, at 8 p.m. in Farmington High School.

The program, as outlined by its creators, would be integrated into the regular curriculum in elementary grades and taught as a separate unit in secondary grades: a four-week class in junior high and a full semester elective in senior high.

The only exception would be specific instruction on human sexuality taught to boys and girls separately by a specially trained instructor in grades 4, 5 and 6.

No evaluations, questionnaires, inventories, or class tests, either written or oral, would be administered.

**Junior and senior** high classes would be taught by a specially selected and trained teacher.

**EVERY SCHOOL** would offer a parent preview of materials to be used and the course outline.

Use of audio-visual materials would be limited to those specified in the course outline, and any changes would require approval of the board of education, program coordinator, community representatives and a committee of selected resource people.

Discussion and teaching of birth control would be banned since they are prohibited by state law.

A parent would have the right, by written request, to have his child withdrawn from a class during units devoted to sex instruction.

Any such child would be provided with "meaningful and constructive educational opportunity" during the time he is withdrawn from the class without penalty.

**THERE REMAIN** many questions to which individual board members said they want specific answers before approval is given or withheld from the program.

Trustee Kenneth F. Perrin, for example, said he wanted a firm figure on its cost.

Trustee Aldo Vagnozzi wanted more emphasis on the "rights of the parents" in sex education.

And both men agreed they want to be satisfied that there is truly a "meaningful substitute" for those children whose parents withdraw them from sex education phases of the course.

Vagnozzi said he also wanted to make certain that a child is not "put in a position of being stigmatized by being pulled out of the classroom."

Trustee Ronald W. Emmitt commented that he hoped such a 9-12 grade course would "reduce the clandestine sex education discussion now going on."

"The subject of sex comes up in all sorts of classes—history, English, biology—and eventually gets into a clandestine discussion by people who don't know what they're talking about," Emmitt said.

"I hope this kind of a class can stop some of the unofficial education going on by itself made experts."

Freedman said his committee "realized the great responsibility involved" in developing such a program and had been mindful of its impact on the youngsters and the care needed in its development.

"We thought how we would feel as parents and our children were exposed to this program," he said. "We're proud of it. I think my two daughters would be better human beings for having taken it."
