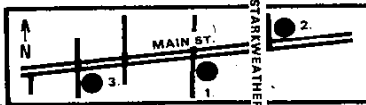

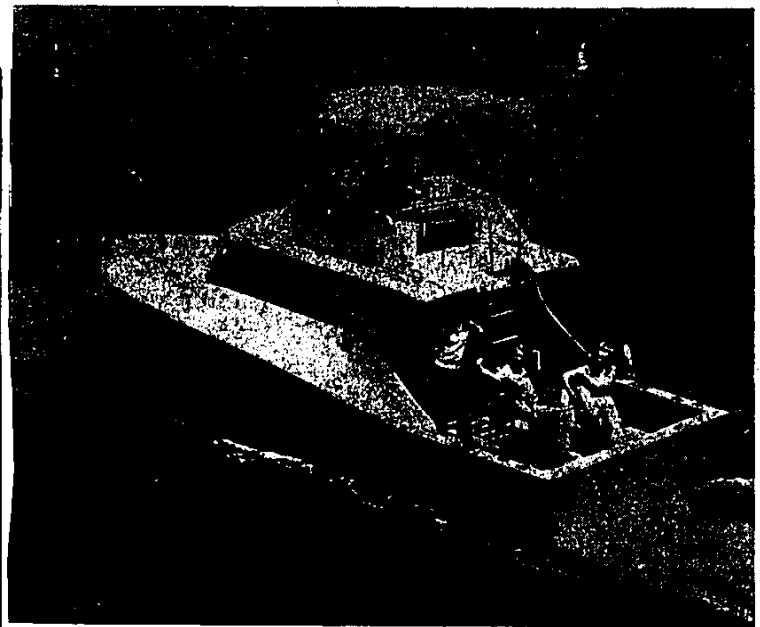

Beat the Blahs . . .

# buy a boat

What could be better than a boat to beat the blahs? Think of the warm, invigorating day dreams that accompany the anticipation of owning your own boat or yacht.

Yacht? Why not? A major boat builder has introduced a new approach to building cruisers, sailboats and power boats.

Enterprise Yachts, Newport Sailboats and Hurricane Power Boats all feature convenience, interior comfort and luxury in a full line of models.

Why? Because of the feminine influence of boat buying, the yacht company is adding built-in mirrors and dressers, care-free galley countertops, stainless steel sinks, contoured deck chairs, larger electric refrigerators, teak trim, cafeteria-style dining areas and more spacious toilet facilities.

These yachts include the Enterprise 37', a magnificent fiberglass yacht with performance and luxury to match her size; and the Newport 27' a racing machine that offers complete comfort in outboard or inboard models.

The forward cabin of the Enterprise 37' extends from the rope locker aft to the main bulkhead, with more than six feet of

headroom. It is equipped with a large enclosed toilet compartment, a built-in mirror and vanity dresser, hanging locker, shelves, storage space and accessories.

The Enterprise 37' also features an overboard drain in the galley countertop, and a spacious 6.5 cubic-foot electric refrigerator.

The galley was designed to turn the floating first mate into a master chef. Where the two-burner stove was, in the past, standard equipment, the company now provides a three-burner stove and oven with storage space.

The Newport 27', designed by Cuthbertson &

Cassian of Ontario, Canada, designers of the Canada's Cup-winning Manitou, sleeps five in complete comfort.

A full galley with top load, food storage lockers,

stainless steel sink, galley pump with fresh water and a spacious 7 cubic-foot ice box highlight the Newport 27'.

The cafeteria-style di-

nette area with care-free table-top converts into a large double berth, six feet four inches long.
