## Christ Church readies carillon concert

Christ Church Cranbrook's 17th annual Christmas carillon concert is slated for 5 p.m. Sunday, Dec. 23. The public is invited, free of charge to enjoy the concert from the warmth of the church through an audio monitor system.

The yuletide concert will be performed by Don Cook, Christ Church Crabrook carilloneuer and associate organist since 1988. His program will feature Christmas favorites for young and old, both sacred and secular. Expect to hear cerything from Silent Night to Santa Claus is Coming to Town.

The carillon is performed from a special keyboard located in the tower directly underneath the bells, leaving the performer

normally Invisible to the audience. But for the first time during the traditional Christmas event the performance may be viewed through a large video monitor. Tours of the tower and beitry will be offered to a limited number of patrons following the concert. Tour reservations will be taken by phone, or if space permits at the door.
