# Journalist talks about 'war nobody wanted'

The renowned international journalist offered his views on Saddam Hussein and the situation in the Persian Gulf to about 250 area residents at the Birmingham Temple in Farmington Illits Monday. His visit was the only Michigam appearance in a national tour sponsored by the New Jowish Agenda, "One thing Milton Viorst does, is he makes us think — and he made us do it tonight," said Ell Master, first vice president of the Birmingham Temple.

AUDIENCE MEMBERS voiced their support of Bush and his action against Iraq, and commented on anti-war raillies, but most came simply to ask questions and become informed.

Viorst's visit comes on the heels of fighting in Iraq and Saudi Arabia—where U.S. and Alitel's toops are saide attacks on Israel by Iraq. Warbroke out after Iraq Invaded neighboring Kuwalt hat August, and Bush gave Husseln an utlimatum to Icave Kuwalt by Jan. 15.

Viorst was one of the first Americans to tour Kuwalt and Baghad after the August invasion.

Viorst paints Husseln as a proud man who grew up in rural Iraq, and who is "shrewt, calculating, a strong nationalist and patriotic." He said the world should understand the fiftee independence the Iraq people feel, after years to domination by the Turks and Christians.

with understanding of its history, and proceed to broader issues including relationships between the Israelis and Arabs in the region and differences between the Arab countries as well.

"How do we put the Humply Dumpty of the Middle East back together again" he said. "I don't think anybody knows. The more deeply we more deeply our feet get stuck."

Vierst said he is impressed with the restraint shown so far by the Israeli government, in not retailating against Hussein's Scud missiles. "Israeli assemb bravery in this war," he added. "Everyone knows Israel is a country of lighters. It's been shown Israel can show come restraint. Israel has taken the moral high ground in this issue, and I hope it stays on the high ground with the war is over."
