Man is charged with kidnapping

A Pontiac man was charged with kidnapping his ex-wife following an incident in Farmington Hills last week.

David Lee Hays, 25, of Pontiac was arraigned on the felony kidnapping charge and a misdemeanor charge of assault and battery Tuesday before District Judge Frederick Harris. He stood mute, and a not-guilty plea was entered on his behalf.

A \$10,000 corporate surety bond was set, and Hays remains in the Oakland County Jail pending a preliminary examination set for 8:30 a.m. Friday, Feb. 1, at Farmington's 47th District Court.

Upon conviction, the kidnapping charge carries a maximum sentence of life in prison.

The incident occurred at about 6 p.m. Jan. 24, when a 29-year-old woman was taken from a friend's house on Oak Valley in Farmington Hills and down the driveway to a waiting car. Sgt. Charles Nebus of the Farmington Hills police said.

The woman was driven around for two hours and eventually dropped off back at her friend's house.

The woman had come to the Farmington Hills house seeking assistance after being assaulted, police said.

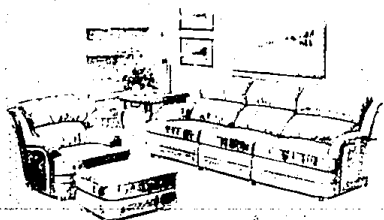
