### OCC grants 27 scholarships.

Oakland Community College has awarded scholarships to 27 students for the winter semester.

Demetra Kazaris of Birmingham and Shannon Kingman of Troy received Board of Trustee Academic Excellence Scholarships.

Other area students and the scholarships they received are: Michael Kozlowski, Farmington Hills, an Orchard Ridge Scholarship; Marguerite Hanselman, Lathrup Village, a Highland Lakes Scholarship; and Karen Azar, Southfield, a Southeast Campus Scholarship.

### OCC's winter enrollment up

The economic downturn is a likely factor in the record enrollment for the winter term at Oakland Community College, according to school spokesman George A. Carlsonis.

Enrollment at the five OCC campuses hit 27,270 for the 1991 semester, or about 2.4 percent higher than the previous record of 26,612 set last winter, Carlsonis reported Friday.

About 79 percent of the students

are part-time, taking 11 credit hours or less. The average class load is 7.1 credit hours per student.

Usually enrollment drops substantially from the fall to the winter semesters, Carlsonis said, sometimes as much as 20 percent. "But this time it didn't happen."

The school's all-time student attendance record was set in the fall, when 28,699 students enrolled.

### OU offers GMAT workshops

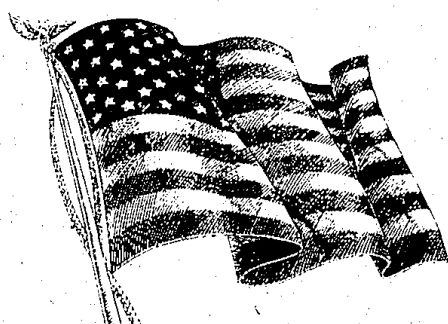

solving, reading comprehension and logical reasoning.

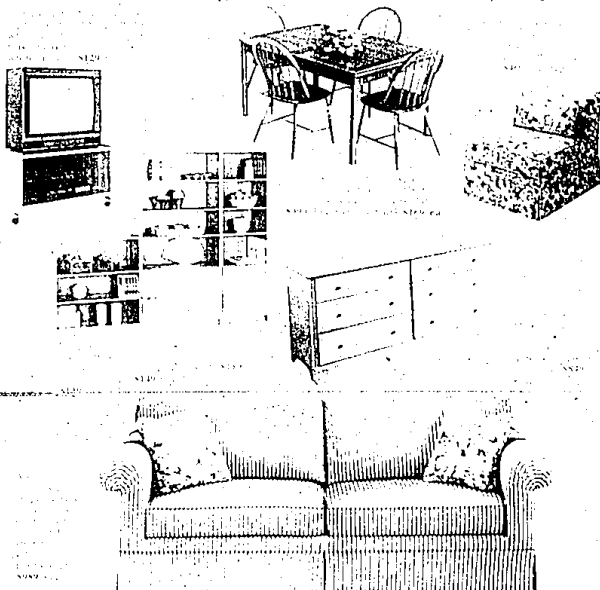
