IRS ALSO WILL suspend all tax return examinations and actions to collect any back taxes owed by these taxpayers for years prior to 1990 un-til at teast 180 days after the taxpay-ers leaves the combat zone. During this time no penalty or interest will be added to any tax due.

"These relief provisions not only apply to armed forces and support personnel serving in the Operation Desert Storm combat zone but also to their spouses," Hummel sald.

Military pay received by enlisted personnel while serving in the combat tone is exempt from income tax. For commissioned officers, up to \$500 a month can be excluded from income. The exclusion generally includes amount received during periods of hospitalization resulting from injury or sickness suffered while serving in the combat zone.

. In the event a member of the armed forces dies while serving in the combat zone, no tax is due for the year of death or any prior year in which the person served in the combat zone. In addition, any unpaid tax for years prior to service in the combat zone is forgiven.

The combat zone designation is of-fective Jan. 17, 1991, and covers Iraq. Kowait, Saudi Arabia, Oma-Bahrain, Oatar, United Arab Empi-rates, Persian Gulf, Red Sea, Gulf of Oman, certain parts of the Arabain Sea and the Gulf of Aden.

Look for full moon

Mars, Aldebaran, and the Pleiades form a large triangle, high in the south, on the evening of the 19th. Mars is eight degrees above Aldebaran. Watch as the moon joins this group in two days. First Quarter moon is at 5.58 p.m. on Feb. 21. It has completed the first quarter of its orbit around the earth. The moon will be located between Mars and the Pleiades later in the evening. By the 22nd the moon has moved past Mars.

WATCH THE MOON move through the constellations of Gemi-ni, Cancer, and Leo starting on the 24th. The moon forms a triangle with the stars Castor and Pollux in

On the 25th the moon is in Cancer, about three degrees above and to the right of Jupiter. (Good luck seeing the Bechive with the bright more seeders). On the one luck seeing the Beehive with the bright moon so closely on the evening of the 26th the moon moves from Cancer into Leo. The moon is three degrees below and to the right of Regulus the lion's "heart") on the 27th.

Full Moon is at 1:25 p.m. on Feb. 28. The moon, still in Leo, is opposite the sun. It will rise in the east and be visible all night. Note Regulus, due cast, 14 degrees above the moon.


