The council Monday approved issuance of \$1.03 million in additional water supply and sewage disposal revenue bonds as a contingency, in case the project exceeds the \$12 million cost approved by voters last spring in application for the sale general obligation bonds.

The project is being done to update the city's sewer system, separating combined sewers and building a new \$2-million plant on site retention tank on the dirt stretch of Nine Mile. The separated sewers will keep untreated sewage discharge into the Rouge River during peak rain periods, "something prohibited by federal and state law."
