

'Road to Mecca' fine exam of artist's role

Mecca" continue through Satur-day, March 9, at the Theatre Guild playhouse in Redford. For ticket information call the box office at 538-5678.

The Theatre Guild's season of plays about artists continues with a splendid, thought provoking production of "The Road to Mecca."

It is by South African playwright Athol Fugard, who has written much about racial strife (most notably "Master Harold and the Boys"). While this play is set in his homeland, it tells of a different sort of inclerance. It is about an artist's struggle to remain true to her vision, which puts her into conflict with her neighbors.

Peggy Joyce is superb as Miss Helen, an aging artist whom the community views as something of an eccentric. An early widow, she copes with the inhospitable quter world by creating her own inner world. Miss Helen constructs welrd con-crete sculptures of owls, camels and

other creatures for her garden—which she calls Meeca. And she bathes her small cottage in candlelight—creating what she calls "a city of light and color more splendid than anything imaginable."

ONCE FIERCELY independent, the onocomformist but enfecibled Miss Helen is faced with the prospect of giving up her statues and garden for an old-age home.

Trying to talk Miss Helen out of this choice is her rebelllous and troubled young friend, Elas, a schoolteacher from Capetown. Paricial Janes brings great energy and insighs to the role of Elsa. At Umes, however, her anger boils over into badgering Miss Helen, which tends to make her less sympathetic. Rick Hudson is excellent as the everand Marines psychol, the villain in the piece. On the surface happears a harmless pastory tooking after the Interests of his flock, which in this case is to get Miss Helen into a home before she burts herself.

It soon becomes quite obvious, however, that the good reverend is really speaking on behalf of a rigid moralistic community which has no loterance for Miss Helen's lifestyle. The residents will stop at nothing to id themselves of the village odbball. Playwright Fugard and director Rebecea Smith combine to show us that we should not be frightened of free thinkers and look upon them as dangeous. On the contrary, the vision artists bring to the world is to be cherished, even if it doesn't agree with our version of the truth.


