Storm sewer improvement work continues along Orchard Lake Road in the city of Farmington. In the above photo, Tom Barron and other workers tunnel under Grand River at Orchard Lake to allow storm water to flow to a settlement pond south of there. Crews have been given permission to work 24 hours a day to get the job done and are expected to complete it in April or May, said city manager Robert Deadman. Orchard Lake Road is closed to through traffic, but those having businesses along the stretch can travel there. After completion of the sewer project, widening of Orchard Lake will begin between Shiawassee and 10 Mile.

"Operation Desert Friend" is our contribution to supporting the troops in the Gulf. Mary Calderone, community outreach coordinator, and Todd Whitman, production specialist, for the Cable Commission have led our involvement with the cause. Through Calderone each of our staff has a pen pal, and each contributed toward this television program. 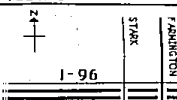

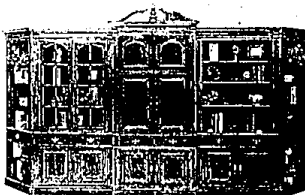

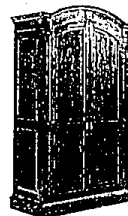
