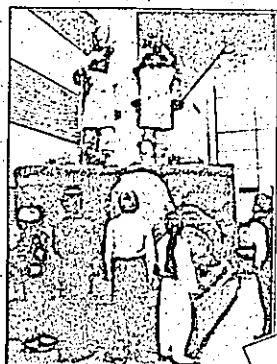

Resort Golf at a Public Course

Timber Ridge Golf Course, from its inception, has been compared to the resort courses of Northern Michigan. Through a beautiful rolling forest, an 18 hole, par 72 golf course was laid out by Jerry Matthews, one of America's premier golf architects. The 6,497 yard Timber Ridge offers great challenge and holds a rare beauty that is truly unique to the Mid-Michigan area. Each hole has a distinctive character that blends perfectly with the natural beauty of the surrounding terrain and woodlands.

Ground was broken in 1987 with the front nine open to play in September of 1988. The back nine opened in the spring of 1989. The natural terrain, along with the thoughtful design by Jerry Matthews, has brought rave reviews from all who have played the course. In 1989 it was named one of the top 5 new golf courses in America by Golf Digest, and in 1990 it made Golf Digest's list of top 75 public courses in America.

The challenging layout has 7 water holes and includes a 47-acre lake guarding the 18th green. Nearly 400 feet separates the courses' highest point from its lowest, combined with the thick forest you won't find a flat straight hole on the course.

Beautifully matured bent grass greens offer the golfer real challenge in reading undulating greens. The putting is true but like the fairways you rarely have a straight flat putt.

Although not a long drive, Timber Ridge is best described as the thinking golfer's course. The best example is on #7. This nice little par 4 can be reached with a driver and a wedge, or a driver and wedge. However, if you choose to use a driver and wedge, you will be hitting your second shot up to the green from a side hill lie. If you stand in the tee and think about how to play the hole, you will tee off with a 3 iron, have a 150 yard shot to the green from a flat lie of lie with the green completely in view.

To help you develop your golf strategy Timber Ridge has a cartilage book, which not only indicates the boulders along the course as 150 yard markers but also contains tips on the best way to play each hole. Although very challenging, there is no hole on the course the average golfer cannot par.

Along with this beautiful golf course Timber Ridge offers a completely stocked and professionally run pro shop, gas powered carts with sun tops, a driving range with a natural turf hitting area, and complete banquet facilities for groups up to 200. The course has a drop set, the tone for a wonderful experience in a fantastic public golf course located in the heart of Mid-Michigan's capital. This award winning golf course is situated on 1,000 acres of beautiful land.
