Mrs. Severo, 79, of Livonia died March 30 in William Beaumont Hospital, Royal Oak.

Born in Detroit, Mrs. Severo was director and owner of Severo Ballet Co. Her initial training began at the Bouffon Theatre at age 14.

Her father disapproved of a daughter on stage, so she did not begin training until his death. Her own chance to perform was abandoned because she rushed training and ruined her feet. This mishap gave her the opportunity to diversify and train as a teacher.

She went on to study with Dimitri Romanoff at Jacob's Pillow, the famous dance farm in Massachusetts. She revered proper training and required the utmost of attention and concentration from her students.

Her career spanned 40 years. The Severo Ballet Company performed the Balanchine version of The Nutcracker with the Detroit Symphony.

Survivors include her sister, Sophia Miller; nephew, John Miller; nieces, Judith Krawczyk and Cornelia Verhalen; nine grandnephews.

Services were held April 3 at the Heeney-Sundquist Funeral Home, Farmington, with the Rev. John B. Crimmons III of Ward Presbyterian Church officiating. Burial was in Oak Grove Cemetery, Superior Township.

County training program eyes move from district

An Oakland County program for severely emotionally impaired high school students, currently housed in the Farmington schools, may move to Southfield.

The 30-student program is at the Farmington Training Center on Thomas Street in downtown Farmington. The district plans to close the

school building and use it as a central cafeteria and warehouse building. The change was proposed as part of the district's recent task force study on building usage. The district has advised county officials it can no longer handle the program.

Oakland Intermediate School District officials propose to move the

program to the Southfield-Lathrup High School after the county district pays to renovate of the school's shop area.

All county special education programs are reimbursed to local districts from Oakland Intermediate, which is funded through a separate property tax millage.
