

Outdoor shoots blossom with spring weather

As the weather captures our hearts, those of us in television gather visions of on-location shoots. Those who know us always have great ideas of activities which we could cover. Be sure to be prepared for such enthusiasm. Arm yourself with "Community Access Broadcasts." Workshops are available 10 months a year. If one must be put on a waiting list then remind them that there are 400 certified television residents who can help them get started, only for the asking.

Also for the on-location resident television crew keep a satchel in your trunk prepared for most any happening, including a mini first-aid kit, sun block, mirror and comb (for windy days), a white balancing card, water bottle, rain gear, masking tape, marker and small change etc.

As you leave the MetroVision studio with your equipment be sure to have anticipated how many videotapes and batteries you will need (re-

membering that the remote ¼ inch run only 20 minutes).

If you have a personal friend who is curious about television but not ready to make a commitment, have them join you on the shoot to be a runner for your crew. This position is very important as the rest of you will be restricted by your position to stay at a specific location.

Enjoy the fun. Remember that we are all available to run ideas by and to share tricks of the trade.
