How to protect

Q: I'm having more and more problems with shoulder pads. They are nice at first but repeated washing or cleaning causes them to love their shape. Then I had a really bad experience: At a hotel convention to the convention of the

A: As if we don't have enough to do, attention to shoulder pads has be-come an added necessity. I did a lit-tile research and here are some

Suit coat pads are sometimes glued in and repeated cleaning can melt the glue. Monitor them closely and repair them when necessary. (That shouldn't happen on good

You can cut out and re-sew loose pads back in for each cleaning, but frankly, that's a pain. Some women remove pads permanently and just wear the same pair that Velcro to their bra straps with everything.

Detachable pads that are attached by Velero to the garment are ideal, but they're only sewn into some clothing. You can make most of them detachable by sewing in Velero yourself, and you can try to buy only clothes with Velero pads in the future.

Lillian Agostinelli, alternations supervisor at Hudson's Northland store, was particularly knowledgeable on this subject and emphasized that prevention is your best bet.

She underscores discussing con-cerns with your cleaners, pointing out pads that need particular atten-tion. If they can't assure your gar-



ment will turn out as you want, look for someone who will give you that

Lillian warns that both cleaners and individuals sometimes press pads out flat. This causes them to loose both their thickness and their curve and can result in unsightly lines showing through clothing.

She said they after pads under-neath by using small gathers to bring the pad into more of a curve, or by loosening material to straight-en them out when needed. Rather than putting them in the dryer, she suggests drije-drying your tops so the pads dry into a natural curve.

Shanta Singh of Chase Cleaners at
Bloomfield Plaza says they watch
pads carefully. On clothes with loos
pads, they pit new safety pins along
the shoulder seam line from underneath. This helps retain their shape,
and prevents wadding up. She encourages customers to return garments for correction if they're unhappy with any aspect of their service.

If you're handy with a needle and thread and have the time, I like to loosely tack various points across your pads with matching thread to ensure the inside padding can't shift around during washing or cleaning.
