

# Hills liquor stores warned of upcoming 'sting'

and beer and wine sellers. This is the department's ninth crackdown since late 1986. Two undercover operations generally are conducted annually, during prom and high school graduation season and the winter holidays.

"Because of the school activities at this time of year, we feel that alcohol is included at some of the events," Dwyer said.

THE PLANNED sting is part of the department's continuing efforts to curtail teen drinking and the sale of alcohol to minors.

The crackdown will again involve the use of an undercover police cadet under 21 years of age who will attempt to buy alcohol. The legal drinking age in Michigan is 21.

Before the cadet leaves the police department on the undercover operation, a photograph will be taken to show the cadet's clothing and appearance during the sting.

"The cadet will be wearing very casual clothes," Dwyer said.

The letter from Dwyer will warn of the impending sting and that licensees as well as employees caught selling liquor or beer or wine to an undercover police cadet under 21 years of age will be ticketed.

"The certainty of dismissal/disciplinary action against employees can be used by licensees as a management incentive to remind employees to protect themselves and their employer," Dwyer wrote in the letter to licensees.

The city council letter will inform licensees of the council's authority, under city ordinance, to recommend that a liquor license be revoked or not renewed because of a licensee's record of selling alcohol to minors. The ordinance allows due process

through a public hearing during which licensees charged with violations or their attorney may present evidence to rebut testimony from city officials and police.

"I don't know what else we can do to show we have no tolerance (for the sale of alcohol to minors)," Sever said.

AS IN PAST stings, violators will be subject to both state liquor laws and city ordinances.

Employees who sell to minors will be cited under a city ordinance that

prohibits the sale of liquor to minors. City ordinance violation is a simple misdemeanor carrying a maximum penalty of 90 days in jail and \$500 fine upon convictions in the 47th District Court of Farmington.

Licensees who sell to minors will be cited under city ordinance and reported to the Michigan Liquor Control Commission. Licensees whose employees sell to minors also will be reported to the state.

The liquor control commission has the authority to levy stiff penalties

as well as suspend or revoke liquor licenses.

In the December 1990 crackdown, seven of the city's 41 bars and restaurants licensed to sell alcohol were ticketed. That represented the best record since the department began the undercover sweeps.

"Overall, there's been an improvement since the first operation," Dwyer said. "There have been a couple occasions when there's been an increase, but overall since its inception there has been improvement."
