three exercise teachers who have a touch of asthma and do very well

three exercise with it.

Having asthma doesn't mean you must sit on the sideline in fear that exertion may bring on an attack. I know doctors agree that daily exercise of some sort is good therapy.

You tell me you're having problems in your exercise class. Probably the first thing to check is the room in which your class takes place. When exercising in a class situation try to avoid dust or other substruct riggers. Choose a studio that is clean and well-wentilated. I can't stress this enough.

exercising in a class situation try to avoid the stringers. Choose a studio that is clean and well-ventilated. I can't stress this enough.

Ask the owners about the ventilation system. Is it pumping out clean fresh air? Are the cellings high? This might help, too. Does your exercise studio have adequate air conditioning and air fifters? I watch people use inhalers – they tell me this will help for a tew hours.

Exercise should have a relaxing effect. Stay calm, even in tough situations, if possible. It is well known that emotional stress can easily trigger an attack by causing byperventilation.

If exercising outdoors, be careful in cold, dry weather. Also, this time of year — wonderful spring — there are a lot of pollens in the air. Wear a surgical mask during your activity.

Anglers lishing Michigan's Great Lakes and connecting waters are being saked to be on the lookout for adjoose fin-clipped trout and salmon by the Fisheries Division of the Dejartment of Natural Resources.


