Shooting suspect to undergo tests

liminary examination on the charges against Hopkins. But Hopkins waived the right entitling him to the exam within 12 days following arrest, and a preliminary examination is expected to be scheduled within five days after receipt of a report on Hopkins from the medical examiner.

Hopkins stood mute to the charges at his Farmington Hills jail-cell arraignment June 1, the day after the shootings. A not guilty plea was entered on his behalf. If convicted of first-degree murder, he faces life in prison.

Hopkins remains in the Oakland County Jail.

The shootings, with a high-powered shotgun, occurred about 7:10 p.m., Friday, May 31, in front of the home of Ernest E. Perry, 40, 20881 Elm Hill Road, Farmington Hills, along Eight Mile, near Inkster. No one else was injured. A business in the area was damaged by shotgun fire.

Hopkins, who lived temporarily at the Inkster Road house surrendered to Livonia police immediately after the shootings on the Farmington Hills-Livonia border, police said.

According to information from witnesses, the two shooting victims were shot in the back of the head two weeks before in Detroit.

WHILE in the courtroom Friday, Hopkins motioned and mumbled to the judge, who ordered the release of two photographs of a series of stitches across the middle of head.

One of the dead men was found on the sidewalk in front of the dark, one-story house on Inkster Road. The other man apparently was shot as he ran from the house. The body of Ernest E. Perry, 40, was found by a dumpster behind Perry's drug store on Eight Mile in Livonia.
