# Rennels wins 3rd board term

Despite her loss, Myers said she was "pleased with the outcome" of Monday's election. Myers and Rennels shared similar views on a number of issues. Myers said she felt she had a strong core of people who supported her views on parent involvement.

DEVRIES SAID he was pleased to have tripled the number of votes he

got compared with last year's board race and thanked his backers who he said were better organized the second time around.

"Obviously I wanted to win," he said. "But I think some positive things came out of it. By the end of the campaign, my opponent, Susan Rennels, actually shifted her platform and recognized the issue of fiscal responsibility."

"I hope that's not empty rhetoric. I hope she and other board members realized that needs to be addressed."

Precincts with the highest voter turnout Monday were the Farmington Training Center, which logged 29 percent of the total turnout, and O.E. Dunckel Middle School with 28 percent.

Warner Middle School had 17 percent, East Middle School 14 percent and absentee ballots represented 12 percent of the total votes cast.

NUMBER AND percentage of votes at individual precincts for each candidate included:

• At Precinct 1 — Farmington Training Center (Myers home precinct): DeVries had 222 votes or 27 percent; Myers had 176 votes or 21 percent; Rennels had 428 votes or 52 percent. Total ballots cast, 826.

• At Precinct 2 — Dunckel (DeVries home precinct): DeVries had 308 votes or 37 percent; Myers had 133 votes or 16 percent; Rennels had 384

votes or 47 percent. Total ballots cast, 825.

• At Precinct 3 — Warner: DeVries had 133 votes or 27 percent; Myers had 54 votes or 11 percent; Rennels had 311 votes or 62 percent. Total ballots cast, 498.

• At Precinct 4 — East (Rennel's home precinct): DeVries had 143

votes or 35 percent; Myers had 27 votes or 7 percent; Rennels had 239 votes or 58 percent. Total ballots cast, 409.

• For Precinct 5 — absentee ballots: DeVries had 100 votes or 29 percent; Myers had 33 votes or 10 percent; Rennels had 211 votes or 61 percent. Absentee votes represent people from throughout the district.

Total ballots cast, 344.

Election camps this year were divided for the three candidates, but much of the election focused on pro- or anti-DeVries sentiment. DeVries reported tampering to his and several neighbors' telephone lines on election day, and some vandalism of campaign signs and to his car several weeks before election day.
