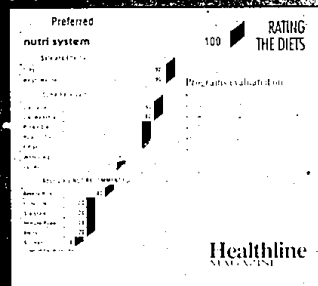

The farm comes to Farmington

Upland Hills Farm will present Fun Farm on Wednesday, June 19 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. in the Downtown Farmington Center.

Farm Fun is a first-hand farm experience where children and adults see, feel and hear the farm. The mobile program includes a dairy cow, goats, pigs, sheep, rabbits, geese, chickens, ducks and a turkey.

The mobile farm program grew from a desire to provide the farm experience to those for whom a farm field trip was either impractical or too expensive.

The first mobile farm trip was in 1982 when Upland Hills visited Jones Elementary in Detroit. Since then the program has gone through snow and sleet to virtually every community in the Metropolitan area, and

visits some 40-50 elementary schools each winter.

Farm Fun is the second program of a 10-part Summer Fun Series presented by the Farmington Downtown Development Authority (DDA), an agency of the city of Farmington committed to maintaining a vibrant and safe downtown district while retaining a small community atmosphere.

Every Wednesday, from June 12 through Aug. 14, an assortment of performances and interactive experiences will take place under the green and white striped tent in downtown Farmington.

The location is at Grand River and Grove Street, one block east of Farmington Road. For further information, contact the DDA office at 473-7276.
