He is promoting the return of quality daily physical education to the nation's schools and encouraging parents to become involved with their children's fitness.

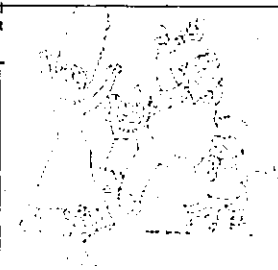
