## Cookbook sales help boost club's donations

The Welcome Wagon Club of Farmington Hills has donated money to the Community Center of Farmington Hills and the Children's Leukemia Foundation of Michigan. Both non-profit organizations received checks for \$697.48.

In 1990, the two organizations received checks for \$219.82. The 1991 donation includes profits from the Welcome Wagon Club's April fashion show luncheon and from cookbook sales.

The club has produced a 336-page cookbook with complete menus and 826 recipes. The Welcome Wagon Club cookbook is spiral-bound and has a durable, washable cover. The Community Center as well as

the Children's Leukemia Foundation of Michigan benefited from sales of the cookbook.

The Community Center is a privately supported, non-profit facility that provides cultural and enrichment activities for all area residents. The Children's Leukemia Foundation, through research and direct patient services, strives to improve the quality of life for both children and adults with leukemia and other blood disorders.

THE WELCOME WAGON Club is also involved with the Salvation Army's adopt-a-family program. The club has adopted two families through The Neighborhood House of Farmington.

The club plans to help four children with school supplies and clothes for the beginning of the 1991 school year. All donations made to this adopt-a-family program are tax-deductible.
