The city bought the new car for about \$11,700, which is a fleet purchase price. Police agencies get together, provide necessary specifications for the cars they want to buy, and consequently get a lower price.

In fact, Cranston said, the Camaro cost the city about \$1,100 less than the typical Chevrolet Impaia police car.


There's no doubt the teal green Camaro fits appropriately into traffic. "It's the color and type of car. People think, "a green police car?" Cranston said.

TRAFFIC OFFICERS have found that indeed the new car generates more traffic tickets. The typical eight-hour traffic enforcement shift generates about 5-7 tickets. 
