Sea the sights at Bar Harbor

Maine shore

has charm

The Atlantic coast of Maine begins at Lubek, across the bridge from Campobello Island, New Brunswick, the Canadian Island where President Franklin Delano Roosevelt spen keildhood summers. It ends at Kittery, a few miles south of Kennebukport, where President George Bush and his family spend their vacation days.

By road, it is 228 miles from Lu-bek to Klittery, but if you stay on Highway 1 you miss the tiny seacoast villages found in every cond and at the end of every rocky penin-sula.

Follow the shoreline and you will travel 3,478 miles to go that same distance from Lubek to Klittery, which tells you everything you need to know about the perils and plea-sures of coastal Maine.

THAT SHORELINE is a meander of rocky penisulas and river estuaries cluttered with lighthouses, boat harbors, Iunky seaports, fishing fleets and salling vessels of every kind.

There are sailboats, fishing boats, motor boats and high masted schooners from Bar Harbor to Rockland and Boothbay Harbor.

You could spend lifetimes exploring all the charms of that winkled coast. Here is one of the hundreds of historial point acceptable from Highway! between Eastport and Brutswick, where Highway I is swallowed up by Interstate 95.

It was off-season when I turned off Route I, looking for just the right accommodation. I didn't want Insury or sophistication, just a place where I could have my morning coffee on a-deck overlooking the sea.

I began to get the picture as I approached town. Emery's Cottages on the Shore: No Vacancy, Court of the Source of the Source

I LOOKED enviously at a deck on an old Tudor house nearby as I

walked back to my car and drove to the Chamber of Commerce. "I didn't expect you to be so busy," I said. "My dream was to have my morning toffee on a porch overlooking the

And that's how I got to a bed-and-breakfast called Ullikans in the Field, that same Tudor house with the very deck that I had seen while walking down the driveway of the Bar Harbor Inn half an hour before. The room cost \$80. Not much sea, but I could see a little patch of water, especially when the wind blew the trees hard enough. I could smell the sea, hear the boat motors, watch the Whale Watching boats come in, And I was just around the corner from the main street of town. Bar Harbor is a great cheerful cultier of shops, restaurants, sea capitain's house, bed-and-breakfasts, tour boats, Itshing boats, people and traffic. If you love to shop, tour and join the lineurs for a variety of New England restaurants, you will love Bar Harbor.

Bar Harbor is a great shops, restaurants, sea captain's houses, bedand-breakfasts, tour boats, fishing boats, people and traffic.

There was an artists' colony and a cottage colony on the island in the 19th century, by the turn of the 20th century the "cettaged" were owned by people like J. P. Morgan, Joseph—Pulitser and John D. Rockefeller. Rockefeller built 37 miles of carriage roads on his 15,000 acres before donating his land to the government as Acadla National Park. The Mount Desert Mountains slope down to the rockbound coast for which Malne is famous.

I spent several hours in the park, exploring the old villages, the inna and the 500 varieties of wildflowers. Then I went "home" to my little porch at Uillkana in the Field.

The next morning, I had my coffee in the breakfast room. I had a wonderful deck that almost overlooked the sea, but it was raining.
