Car-crash injuries kill Hills woman

A Farmington Hills woman died Wednesday afternoon of injuries suffered in a Tuesday night collision on Seven Mile Road in Livonia, police said.
Killed in the two-car crash was Beatrice Margaret Fisher, 79.
The cause of the accident was still under investigation Thursday, said Sgt. Thomas Green of the Livonia Police traffic bureau.
Preliminary reports indicated that Fisher failed to yield to the oncoming car, police said.
Fisher was pronounced dead at University of Michigan Hospital at 2:07 p.m. after suffering multiple injuries, including a lacerated aorta, the artery which carries blood from the heart.
She had been transferred to U-M from Botsford Hospital in Farmington Hills, where she was taken following the 10:10 p.m. accident, police said.
Police said Fisher was pulling out of a driveway at the VFW Hall on Seven Mile, east of Middlebelt, when her 1983 Chevrolet was struck by a 1990 passenger car headed eastbound on Seven Mile.
"She was turning left and was at an angle when the car was hit almost head-on," Green said.
The driver of the other car, who wasn't identified by police, suffered minor injuries and was also taken to Botsford Hospital.
