Chuck Woolery once topped music charts

In case you hadn't noticed, another talk show has hit the airwaves. There won't be any mutant extraterrestrials on this show, but there will be candid and relaxed interviews with top entertainment personalities on *The Chuck Woolery Show*.  
Host Chuck Woolery was born and raised in Ashland, Ky. While studying economics at Morehead State University, he moonlighted as a country and western singer. After a stint in the Navy, Woolery worked as a wine consultant and then as a representative

for Pillsbury.  
Music, however, still called to him. Woolery returned to Nashville, Tenn., and formed the rock group Avant Garde. In 1968, their single "Naturally Stoned," which Woolery wrote and produced, topped the charts. The group broke up, but Woolery signed a recording contract and moved to Los Angeles, where he became interested in acting.  
Woolery's early roles included a part on the children's series *New Zoo Revue* and a role opposite Cheryl Ladd in *Jamaica Reef*. An appearance on *The Merv Griffin Show* led to an audition for the job of host on the newly created game show *Wheel of Fortune*, where he served as host through 1982. Host duties on *Scrabble* followed.  
Woolery also serves as host of *The Love Connection*.
