

# Area seniors named scholarship semifinalists

Ninety-six area high school seniors have been named semifinalists in the 1992 National Merit Scholarship competition. Semifinalists have an opportunity to advance to the next level in the competition for some 6,100 Merit Scholarships, worth approximately \$25 million, which will be awarded next spring.

They are eligible for college scholarships based on their scores on the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test, given last spring to juniors in over 19,000 high schools across the country.

# Blacks in running for achievement grants

Thirteen area students have been named semifinalists in the 1992 National Achievement Scholarship Program for Outstanding Negro Students.

They are among 1,500 students who will have an opportunity to continue in the competition for some 750 Achievement Scholarships to be awarded next spring.

Nearly 90,000 black students from across the country entered the 1992 competition by requesting consideration when they took the 1990 Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test last spring.

Just as in the Merit Scholarship competition, semifinalists must now advance to the finalist level of the competition. Those scholarship winners will be announced next spring.
