'H' User Didn't Get Addicted

Q. Everybody tries to make you believe that heroin is addicting. I personally know someone who has been using it cautiously for a year and is not addicted. This doesn't make me want to try it, but how can you believe any of the bad things that are said about drugs in the face of facts like this?

J. M., Westland

A. It is true that some individuals may "chop" (use heroin occasionally) for some time without becoming addicted. This is definitely the exception to the rule. The odds against this are roughly the same as playing Russian roulette occasionally with bullets in five chambers and not having a perforated skull. Some of the factors involved are these:

1) Your friend's "heroine" may be so badly "cut" or adulterated that it has very weakly addicting properties.

2) Even without addiction your friend is laying his life on the line every time he shoots up. Should he get some pure stuff for a change, he could die of an overdose.

3) Addicted or not, a heroin user continuously risks the danger of contracting hepatitis, a disease which may be lethal.

This points out the fact that addiction is only one of the dangers of heroin use.

Q. This is weird, but I've heard from a very good source that you can get high from smoking the rolls of dust that you find under beds and in corners. Any comments?

M. J., Clarenceville

A. We're here to answer any and all questions, so here goes. Apparently "you" rather ask about it than try it, and we don't blame you.

Several factors are likely involved here. Some of the most bizarre things are smoked or inhaled for a high. The effect, if any, is often due to merely shutting off

the normal supply of oxygen to the brain with resultant dizziness. In most cases the same effect could be gotten by holding one's breath for as long as possible.

The other factor is that of auto-suggestion; it's amazing how people can get an effect merely because they believe they will. This particularly type of reaction seems childish, but it could be potentially dangerous for an allergic person or for one prone to asthma.

Q. Is it true that you can't get addicted by a drug unless you "shoot it up" (inject it)?

D. E., Livonia

A. No, matter of fact, addiction was a problem long before the discovery of the hypodermic syringe or needle. This instrument was used in the early stages to administer narcotics because it was then highly but erroneously believed that you could not become addicted by injection.

Q. What is a "mike"?

D. L., Westland

A. A mike is a microgram. It is such a small measure of weight that there are 300,000 micrograms in an ounce. One ounce of LSD for example can produce as many as 4,000 human doses large enough to cause hallucinations. It is easy to see how people get bad and inaccurate doses so often with this drug.
