Miss Nilah Clay of Williamston was the guest of her cousin, Mrs. John Mercer, Sunday.

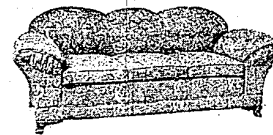
Mrs. Harry Wolfe is recovering from a bad case of flu.
