

A. It has still not been
proven that LSD does not
causebirthdefects in humans.
All that has been pretty well
established is that this drug
does not cause birth defects
in certain animals that were does not cause birth defects in certain animals that were tested. The possibility still remains that LSD may be implicated in human fetal abnormalities. Just remember that Thalidomide produced no birth defects in certain animals.

And by the way, it is gen-erally agreed that psychotic episodes may be dangerous and can be brought about by LSD. So there are dangers inherent in the drug other than the one you refer to.

Q. What do you think if arents take tranquilizers, is

A. In most instances, tranquilizers are taken by adults rightfully. There are a number of situations, however, in which adults do abuse transparents.

Legitimate iranquilizers are obtained in some cases from black market sources rather than on a physician's prescription. Some people obtain this sort of medication by lying to a physician about some control of the sort of the properties of the sort of the properties of the prope

authorized just a few examples of how adults may be "wrong" in taking drugs. And by wrong we mean that they may be endangering their health. The only "right" way for one to take tranquilizers is on a prescription by a physician.
