**PUBLIC ASKED TO LEARN PRONE PRESSURE METHOD OF RESUSCITATION**

In an effort to reduce the needless sacrifice of life in water accidents this summer, the public utility information bureau here has issued an appeal to the citizens of Michigan to learn the prone pressure method of resuscitation.

Swimming and boating mishaps need not end in tragedy, according to the bureau, if someone is present who knows this simple method of reviving persons who apparently have drowned.

"No equipment is needed to apply the prone pressure method of resuscitation," the bureau's statements said. "Employees of the state's gas and electric companies are trained to use this method, which is effective in cases of asphyxiation and shock as well as drowning." They will gladly demonstrate the method to anyone upon request."
