

RU's Randy Fergerson Hangs Up 7th Victory

Seven victories in a season would make any high school pitcher happy.

Randy Fergerson of Redford Union already has seven and the season is hardly half completed.

He posted No. 7 without a loss by beating Plymouth, 4-1.

The victory kept the Panthers atop the Suburban Six League standings with a 4-0 record.

FERGERSON DID have one streak snapped. He was touched for the first earned run in four league games when Steve Straley doubled and

came home on Howie Schryer's single in the fourth inning.

Redford Union scored in the third when Bob Campbell singled, R.J. Reaux tripled and Mickey Robinson singled. In the fifth Robinson walked, Bill Booker made a

three-for-three with his third single, the two pulled off a double steal and Bill Herbert doubled them in.

Brad Trux started for Plymouth and lasted until the fifth inning.

Fergerson allowed six hits, walked six and struck out six.

MEANTIME, Bentley's defending league champions finally notched their loop win after losing three in a row by routing Trenton, 9-0.

Bill Duncan tossed a three hitter, fanned seven and walked one in turning in the

best pitching effort of the season by a Bentley pitcher.

Bentley took a 2-0 lead in the first inning after two were out when Al Hernandez was safe on an error, Bob Sitkauskas tripled and Ed Leavell was safe on an error.

Then in the second, Bentley added another run when John Gentz was hit by a pitch, Duncan singled him to third and Bill Boehm squeezed him in.

That's the way the score stood until the seventh when

Duncan singled to lead off a six run explosion for Bentley.

After Boehm walked, Paul Seventy was safe on an error to jam the bases.

Hernandez cleared the bases with a triple, Leavell followed with a single, Ken Grant was safe on a fielder's choice and John Spreitzer singled to wrap up the uprisings.

Franklin, Glenn Thurston In Tie

There's a collision atop the standings in the Northwest Suburban baseball standings.

With the season approaching the halfway mark Monday, three teams — Livonia Franklin, Thurston and John Glenn — share the top spot.

Each has a 3-1 record after Franklin ended Glenn's winning ways, 6-0, while Thurston turned back Oak Park, 9-2.

GLENN HAD WON three straight in the league to set the early pace, but in the game against Franklin, Glenn simply found pitcher Tony Kaseta, too much.

The Kaseta statistics pretty much told the story of how the game went. He allowed two hits — the first to Roger Sanders in the fifth inning and the second to Mike Berkins in the seventh.

Meantime, Franklin gave Kaseta some working room by scoring twice in the third inning

and then notching four more runs in the fifth.

John Grills singled in the third and came around when Tom Battistone parked a homer into deep right field.

Then in the fifth, Grills strided things again with a single. Battistone unloaded again — this time with a triple — to score Grills. Don Opland and Paul Sopchik followed with singles and Rob Hollandsworth a double to wrap it up for Franklin.

STEVE KREAGER buried his third win against one loss in Thurston's easy win over Oak Park.

Neither of Oak Park's runs were earned as Kreager scattered two hits, fanned nine and walked five.

Thurston shot in front in the first, scoring runs on walks to John King and Dennis Poppenger, a two run double by Larry Poma and an error.

In the fourth, Kreager belted his own cause when he socked a homer after John Stein was safe at first on an error.

Then Thurston pushed over four more runs in the sixth when Bruce Holben singled, Ken Chopek walked and John King walked to fill the bases.

Scott Irwin singled in two runs, another came in on an error and the fourth and final run of the inning crossed after Don Murdock doubled.
