Royal Academy classes led to role as Freddy

Beneath the latex scars and the razor-tipped fingers of Freddy Krueger's character actor Robert Englund.

Raised in California, Englund began acting in a children's theater program. After high school, he was accepted at the Royal Academy of Dramatic Art and enrolled in their American school in Michigan. In addition to his studies, he appeared at the prestigious Meadowbrook Theater and in a

Cleveland company production of *Godspell*. By age 25, Englund had played every clown from Shakespeare's plays.

While working in Detroit, Englund was introduced to the art director of the film *Badlands*, and he went to Los Angeles to audition for the film. He didn't get that part, but was soon cast in *Buster and Billie* (1974). After a number of other film appearances, he

landed the role of Willie in the critically acclaimed 1983 miniseries *V*. To avoid being typecast, he went after the part of Freddy Krueger. After convincing director Wes Craven he was right for the part, Englund was cast as the witty revenant spirit.

Nightmare on Elm Street broke box-office records. Freddy dolls became a merchandising phenomenon. Englund is now appearing in the sixth, and supposedly final, *Elm Street* movie and is working on a midseason replacement series, *Nightmare Cafe*, for NBC.
