Dee Woods' involvement with pot-ery began as a reaction to tragedy and evolved into a triumph. Two decades ago, Woods searched or something to help her through her grief over a death in the family.

Then Woods discovered clay.

Now the public can discover her pottery when Woods' work is among that of nine potters exhibited Thursday-Friday, Nov. 7-8, at the Townsend Hotel, 100 Townsend, south of Maple and west of Woodward in Birmingham.

IT WASN'T surprising that Woods, who painted watercolors while her four daughters were growing up, turned to pottery. Like the watercolors, pottery fulfilled her need to be creative.

Before her marriage, she was an interior design student at the University of Cincinnaul School of Applied Arts. When her family was young, they moved frequently to meet the demands of her husband's job. By the time they settled in Bloomfield Township 21 years ago, Woods began to turn to watercolors as a way to express herself.

Eventually, Woods began to work
in clay and started taking clases at
the Birmingham Bloomtield Art Association, Center for Creative Studties and finally Odkiand Community
College, Royal Dak.

THROUGH THE years, the factlle aspects of pottery continue to appeal to her. She continues to turn out a lot of hand-built things instead of relying solely on using a wheel.

As time goes on, Woods has become more interested in raku, which is mostly hand-built pottery and non-functional.

Harking back to the days when she painted at home, the treatment of her raku work has a solt, watercolor effect.

SHE STARTED out making most-ly functional pieces, a choice that's part personal preference and part marketing decision.

Woods, who'll only say she's over 50, became involved in shows for equally practical reasons.

"Once you start out to produce, you need an outlet."

RESPONSE TO her work has been so positive that its demands approach a full-time job.

"This hobby turned into something more than it started."
