AS FAMILY members arrived at the courtroom Wednesday morning, uniformed Farmington Hills stiflers checked everyone with a metal delector to ensure that weapons were not being taken into the courtroom. Farmington Hills detectives and uniformed differs remained in the courtroom. Oakland County assistant prosecutor Genevieve Marur asked that family members — on both aides — be allowed to remain in the courtroom. Harris consented. Closing arguments will be made Dec. 3 by defense attorney Tom McGlants of Birmingham and Marur. Judge Fred Harris will then determine whether Hopkins will the bound over for trial in Cakland County Circuit Court. Hopkins remains without bond in the Oakland County Jaill. MOPKINS' BROTHER, Mikel Hopkins, testified in October that Edward Hopkins shot Carter and Preston because they had beaten him a week earlier at a Detroit-crack house and returned to the Farmington Hills house to collect a drug debt May 31.

He also testified earlier that the beating occurred after Edward Hopkins put his car up for collateral on the debt and the two Detroit men found out there was a lien on the car's tills.

DeGrande also testified that Hopkins told him he aimed the shotgun at Ricardo Preston but his Carter.
