Those who aren't sensitive should be, local law enforcement officials said.

sald.

In Farmington, police sald it is illegal for video store owners and employees — or anyone else — to subject minor children to such vulgarity, either from screens or speakers.

"Our ordinance is very specific."

sald Gary Goss, deputy public safety director. "My concern is that stores are inadvertently showing these videos to children. That's wrong and its against the law."

GOSS SAID had visited other stores in Farmington and found no problems.

He does not consider the issue one of censorship. They are not telling the stores what to rent or sell, just


what they can display especially to minor children. "There is a community standard here," added Goss, who was contacted by Claridge and subsequent researched the Farmington incident. In Farmington Itilis, Police Chief William Dwyer said he does not believe such problems are widespread, but said he would issuing a warning if there was a problem.

Dwyer said, after talking with the Gakiand County Prosecutor's office, he does not believe there is anything illegal in profamity from a videotape, especially in light of what can be seen on television today.

"I certainly understand her concerns and sympathize," he said. "If there's nothing enforceable, I would certainly go into the stores and warn them if it became a problem."
