pointed star to remind us that we are all part of a great universe with untold cosmic forces. It reminds some people of the Star of Bethlehem that led the wisemen to the stable.

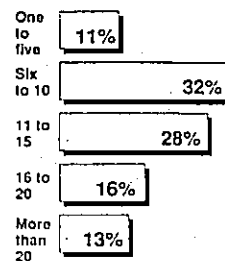
When you break open the center of the sand dollar, you will find five little white doves, representing peace on earth, and goodwill toward men.

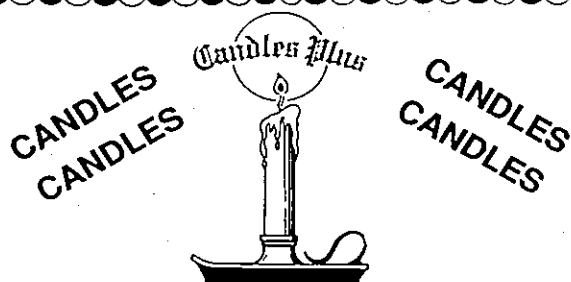

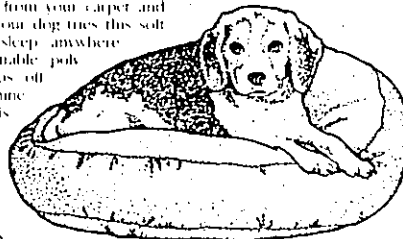
