Students work to open housing for the poor

Parts of Detroit's Jeffries Housing Projects are a step closes to re-opening, thanks in part to a group of Madona University students, including Tim Nadon of Farmington Hills. The students began working at the stark, red brick complex, Just west of the Lodge Expressawy near Martin Luther King Boulevard, before Thanksgiving and are scheduled to spent several coming Saturdays finishing the job. "We've been stripping off paint and doing cleanup work," said Joanne Hinds of Northville, one of the six Madonan students. "We're trying to renovate two buildings," Habitat for Humanity spokeswoman Elizabeth Pierce said.
"There are about 72 units we hope to have open for low income families, elderly people and singles."

Workers hope the buildings will be ready for occupancy by Dec. 15, Pl-erce said. Those moving in are ex-pected to include people who were recently deleted from state welfare

The Madonna students are among five groups assisting in the project. In addition to scraping paint, the Madonna volunteers have also been clearing away dust and debris and moving out old, abandoned furniture, among other tasks.

The work can get messy, Gyuran said.

"I REMEMBER peeling paint off one wall and ending up peeling off pretty much the whole wall," she said. "I said, "That's enough for here."

But she said it's also satisfying.
"I know we've had a lot of other people volunteer since we began working," Gyuran said. Volunteers need not be affiliated with Madonna, she added.

The Madonna group also includes Todd Martin and Kerl Northway of Redford and Suzette Beauchamp of South Lyon. Volunteers represent three student organizations, including the college social work club. Group members plan at least two
